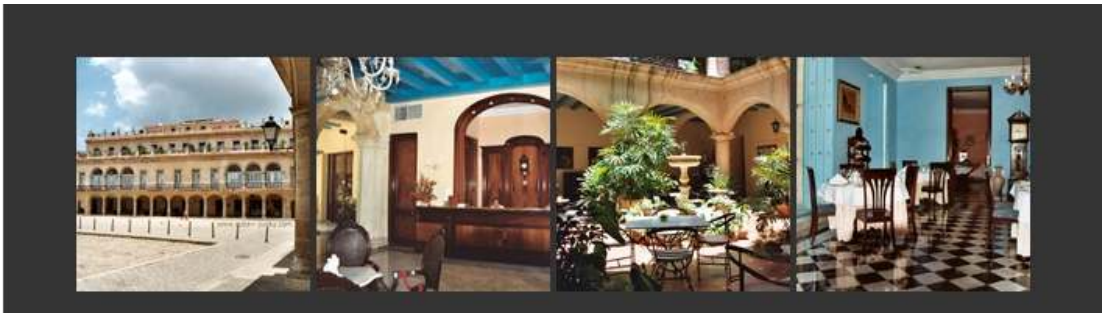


# Hotel Santa Isabel
